About the League

The McDonalds Ballarat FNL is the major football and netball league in Ballarat and surrounds, catering for competition across all age groups and demographics. The league is a progressive organisation looking to maximise participation for all members of the community.

About the Role

The role of Netball Umpire Coordinator is to facilitate umpire education and training across the Ballarat FNL.

Working alongside the BFNL Netball Manager, the successful candidate will assist with the growth and development of umpires in the premier netball competition in Ballarat and surrounds.

Terms

The role is for a fixed period commencing early April 2021 and finishing late September 2021, in conjunction with the BFNL competition seasons.

Prerequisite

A minimum of "C" Badge umpire accreditation is required with five or more years' experience. Preference given to a "tester"; however, this is not a requirement.

Key Tasks

- Training and skills sessions for umpires participating in the BFNL Umpire Development Program
- Identify TID umpires for Association Championships.
- Liaise with high performance mentors and BFNL Netball Manager for TID umpires
- Coordinate the rostering of finals umpires for BFNL senior and junior competitions.
- Assist clubs to seek and retain umpires for weekly matches during the Home & Away season
- Mentor and oversee the BFNL Umpire Development Program
- Training and education for club mentors
- Observe umpires within the Umpire Development Program and provide feedback.
- Umpire games across the BFNL competitions where required.

The key tasks mentioned are not exhaustive of the role and will include further development and administration tasks.
